NEW STANDARD TEMPLATES

All clients using the **standard suite** of Savv-e Express templates will have access to the following new screen templates:

1. T150: Multiple choice with audio introduction (landscape image orientation)
2. T151: Multiple choice with video introduction (landscape image orientation)
3. T152: Hotspot multiple choice
4. T153: True/False multiple choice
5. T154: Full-screen hotspot with multiple overlay screens
 - a. Landscape image with single column text
 - b. Portrait image with double column text
 - c. Video with short accompanying text
6. T155: Audio and graphic multiple choice (landscape image orientation)
7. T156: Video and graphic multiple choice (landscape image orientation)

Note: Clients using custom course structures will not have access to these templates.

NEW FEATURES

All clients

1. 'Hide results' function: For relevant assessment templates, you'll be able to check a 'Hide results' box that will automatically stop the correct response(s) from being highlighted, as well as hiding any correct/incorrect feedback. This functionality ensures that learners will not receive any hints to guide their responses when reattempting the assessment.
2. Publish CD version to Mac: For all you Mac users out there, you'll now be able to publish CD/local versions of your courses that can be run directly from your local computer, or burned to a CD/DVD and distributed to other Mac users.
3. ASK LMS publish update: For clients using the ASK LMS, when you publish your courses, you will now receive files for both the 2006 and 2009 versions. You can then simply select and apply the appropriate launch file.
4. Completion certificate update: For our clients who are using the Savv-e Central platform in addition to the Savv-e Express tool, completion certificates will now automatically populate with the learner details (i.e. first and last name). For our clients not using Savv-e Central, there has been a small wording change to the instructions on the completion certificate, but the functionality remains unchanged.

Savv-e Central clients only

1. Upload SCORM courses: You'll now be able to upload external SCORM-compliant courses to Savv-e Central, and add them to your training catalogue. There are a range of options and parameters that you'll be able to customise, to ensure that the loading of your SCORM course meets your requirements. When the update is released, we'll provide a document detailing everything you'll need to know to upload your SCORM courses to Savv-e Central.
